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Rhode Island State law requires that all students entering Kindergarten, seventh grade and all out - of - state transfer students must show evidence of a physical examination 12 months prior to or 6 months after entering school. YOUR CHILD MAY NOT ENTER SCHOOL WITHOUT PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION.

The Rhode Island Department of Health immunization regulations are as follows:
